Hale Wharf is situated off Ferry Lane, close to Tottenham Hale rail and underground stations. The site offers a major regeneration opportunity and plans for the scheme include 500 new homes including affordable family housing, the potential for modern business space, new shops and restaurants and reinvigorated canal-side public realm. Hale Wharf has been designated as one of the Mayor of London's Housing Zones, meaning the site will make an important contribution to the Mayor's and the Council's aspiration for 2,000 new homes in Tottenham Hale.

In addition to the homes, the scheme will also include a new bridge across the Lee Navigation, providing a vital new link through to the site, as well as enhancements to pedestrian routes. The water's edge will also be regenerated thanks to upgrading the access routes to the commercial barges as well as canal wall repairs and the addition of floating reed beds.

Residents will also be able to benefit from access to the Paddock Community Nature Park which will play a key role in the Council's new 'Green Grid Strategy' which seeks to improve this space for the local community.

Low-interest loans and support to help your business succeed



The Opportunity Investment Fund (OIF) is a £3.67m business loan fund jointly provided by Haringey Council and the Mayor of London. The OIF helps businesses to create or improve work space, purchase machinery or production equipment, generate new jobs and invest in training for existing staff in Tottenham.

Loans are available for capital works including building refurbishment, equipment but not for revenue purposes such as salaries or to pay off other loans.

Who should apply?

The fund is open to both existing businesses and start-ups. We are interested in businesses that want to grow and create high quality employment with good opportunities for career progression.

We want the Opportunity Investment Fund to give businesses the chance to showcase their products and services at the next level, helping businesses to achieve their full potential.

What are the loan size and terms?

Loans are negotiable but typically £100k with competitive interest rates repayable over several years. Additional funding from other sources is desirable but not essential.

A full package of support

Alongside OIF funding we have created a full package of business support. Businesses that occupy new offices and workspaces can apply for 30% discount


on their business rates, lasting three consecutive years. This could mean a saving of up to £5,000 per year.

There are also strong traders groups that operate throughout the borough including the Tottenham Traders Partnership and Haringey Business Alliance where members can share experiences with other traders and promote their businesses. Business support advisers are also on hand to assist with your application and other business needs.

To date, £835k has been loaned out which will create 51 new jobs and deliver 33,000 ft² of commercial space with over £2m still available to lend. The fund has supported an exciting, diverse range of growing businesses – could you be next?

Case Study

The Albion Knitting Company

Co-founder: Christian Murphy

Established: 2014



Why the name?

"I've been working in China in textiles for 18 years and when we decided to establish a second supplementary business, to re-start knitwear manufacturing in London, we felt we wanted a name which really reflected British history and gave us a British identity. Albion is the old Celtic name for Britain so it seemed like a good choice."

Why Tottenham?

"This area is one of the better choices because there is some manufacturing space left. Having been to university in London I know this area well and many of the design talents in our luxury fashion industry also live in this area. And the reason we chose this particular industrial estate is because of the great people next door at Fashion Enter who have been very helpful in giving us advice."

Fun fact

The Albion Knitting Company is believed to be the first fully-fashioned flat knitting company that has opened in London since World War Two. It is also believed to be the biggest factory of its kind in the capital.

Christian says:

"Flat knitting differs from circular pattern knitting because we can deal with more complex designs. We have specialists from China working with us and training apprentices and we generally focus on making high end garments for luxury brands and designers such as Alexander McQueen, Paul Smith, Victoria Beckham and M&S."

"At the moment we can make about 2,500 garments a month but we would like to double that capacity within two years. We also employ around 30 staff but – if we have access to enough industrial space – we have the potential to employ 100 people in here over the next five years. We really want to inspire the next generation to become involved in manufacturing and we work closely with universities to take on graduates and help them forge a pathway in their own careers."

"The UK has a surfeit of great design talents but I would love young people interested in fashion and textiles to consider a great future in manufacturing. Here you can learn unique skills that put you in a very small pool of talent. We want to be seen as part of a revival in re-shoring some manufacturing back to Britain and take great pride in our 'Made in England' label. I would like London to be known as a knitwear manufacturing destination."

Haringey's future is bright, with hundreds of millions of pounds of investment pouring in and many more people choosing to make the borough their home.

There is much to enjoy in Haringey, and our fantastic array of local businesses and high streets epitomise the variety on offer across the borough.

This guide offers a taste of the very best in Haringey's businesses – from the village charms of Highgate and Muswell Hill to the multicultural cafés of Green Lanes and the independent companies making Tottenham their home.

Highgate Village

Occupying the most south-westerly point of Haringey, Highgate enjoys an envious hilltop location overlooking Hampstead Heath and central London – it's no surprise then that Highgate boasts a number of famous faces amongst its residents. Local organisations such as the Highgate Society and Highgate Literary & Scientific Institute ensure community is at the heart of life in Highgate.

The charming Highgate High Street is home to an eclectic array of independent stores, well-known names and restaurants and bars to suit every taste. Browse for your next read at the independent Highgate Bookshop; pick up tasty fresh food at the Highgate Village Fruiterers; find a rare wine at Bottle & Basket; grab the perfect gift at the Village Jeweller, or take home a delicious cut of meat from the Village Butchers.

If shopping or walking on the nearby Hampstead Heath has worn you out, there are so many places to stop for a refresher and watch the world go by – from tea rooms to traditional pubs, and laid back cafés to fine dining restaurants.

Crouch End

Undoubtedly one of north London's most popular spots both to live and visit, Crouch End enjoys a laid-back, family-friendly vibe and a reputation as a hub for media and creative types.

Dining out is a Crouch End institution, with a range of restaurants, pubs and bars to rival the best London has to offer – from intimate fine-dining eateries like Bistro Aix to lively neighbourhood favourites such as Banners and Monkeynuts, and delicious deli treats and cakes at Red Pepper Jelly. After eating, there's plenty of entertainment to be had in Crouch End, including live comedy at Downstairs at the Kings Head, the best in cinema at the Arthouse and live bands at a number of local pubs.

If fashion's your thing, Crouch End is definitely the place to shop – with a range of quirky independent clothing and accessories boutiques from vintage delights at Scarlet Rage to designer rags at Broadway or a nearly-new bargain at Change of Heart.

Crouch End is also home to a host of independent traders, from the famous Dunn's Bakery to eclectic home accessories at Indish and the best in second-hand music at Flash Back.

Muswell Hill

Centred around the buzzing Broadway and the recently unveiled continental-style piazza, Muswell Hill boasts beautiful architecture, peaceful tree-lined avenues and a thriving shopping core with some of the highest-regarded high street names rubbing shoulders with much-loved independent shops.

Step back in time at W Martyn, an independent grocers' shop that has been filling the air with the aroma of roasting coffee beans and selling the finest biscuits and treats from the same spot for more than 100 years.

Find the latest fashion at Charli or Whistles; pick up fabulous children's clothing at Frocks Away; browse for books at the Muswell Hill Bookshop

and the Children's Bookshop; stock up on kitchen equipment at the Scullery; get creative at Art for Art's Sake, or kick-back with a movie at the recently opened Everyman Cinema in the art deco former Odeon building, followed by dinner at any one of Muswell Hill's top restaurants.

Hornsey High Street

So much more than Crouch End's little brother, Hornsey High Street has a history and atmosphere all its own and is a fun place to while away an afternoon or evening.

The Grade II listed Great Northern Railway Tavern is a nostalgia-drenched venue to enjoy a drink, while the Three Compasses pub and restaurants including Tomo's Pizzeria, Olive and Le Bistro bring modern British and European cooking to the local food scene. Hornsey has also carved out a niche for antique adventures, with shops such as Palace Antiques, Little Treasures and Mishka adding to the vintage vibe.

There's even more to come for Hornsey, with exciting regeneration set to bring more housing and a raft of improvements to the high street in coming months.

West Green Road

This bustling, lively area boasts a great variety of independent shops and cafés, and visitors are instantly struck by the real sense of community here.

West Green Road caters for a great diversity of people, including the Caribbean and West Indian community and has a busy vibe thanks to the Underground and Overground stations at Seven Sisters.

The area is currently benefiting from thousands of pounds of investment with the creation of a 'tropical oasis' – inspired by the locality's cultural diversity – of a colourful pocket park and community garden at the junction with Houghton Road, while a number of shop fronts have enjoyed stunning makeovers, which have already attracted many new customers.

The park adds further green space to an area where people already enjoy the beautiful, historic Downhills Park and the nearby Chestnuts Park, which has been a Green Flag Award Winner since 2008.

Tottenham High Road

At the heart of Tottenham's massive regeneration project lies the High Road. Following the course of an ancient



Roman road, this invigorating promenade still buzzes with the sounds and sights of an incredible variety of cultures spilling out of the many independent shops and into the street to discuss the issues of the day.

One hot topic – reflected in the white and blue exteriors of many shops and pubs – is Tottenham Hotspur Football Club. The Premier League club has made the High Road its home and work is underway to lay the foundations for a stunning new 61,000 seat stadium, which will make it the capital's biggest club football venue.

With the local community at the heart of the development, the scheme will bring new homes, schools and museums to complement the already open

supermarket and the state-of-the-art University Technical College, officially opened by Sir Alan Sugar in March.

Boasting superb transport links, Tottenham High Road is one of the best connected, vibrant and happening areas in north London.

Wood Green

Well known as one of London's busiest shopping districts, Wood Green is home to the Mall shopping centre and a packed high street boasting some of the biggest names in fashion alongside a great array of independent stores. Recent improvements have brought a brighter environment with wider pavements, new benches and trees to allow people to take a breather and watch the world go by.

Throw into the mix two cinemas, a range of pubs and restaurants, the up-and-coming cultural quarter – home to artists' studios the Chocolate Factory – quirky independents such as the Big Green Bookshop and a great sense of community amongst local residents, and you have the ingredients for one of Haringey's most bustling areas.

Green Lanes

Green Lanes has a richly deserved reputation as one of the most culturally diverse areas in the whole of London,

a characteristic that is manifested in its truly global cuisine.

THE place for world food, Green Lanes' restaurant, bar and café culture brings a unique atmosphere on a par with some of Europe's liveliest town centres – with the very best in Mediterranean flavours, from Greek to Turkish and Spanish to Italian.
